How office and field

Who is Ilm-o-Amal?

Ilm-o-Amal is a network of volunteers. It is managed by young Pakistanis from different walks of life including professionals, homemakers, students and entrepreneurs.

All our welfare activities to help deserving families are managed by our volunteers and part time staff.

All our funds are contributed by our members and socially aware individuals.

What is our Business Model?

It is reasonable to expect that donations should be used to alleviate the suffering of a deserving person instead of paying for an air-conditioned office in a posh neighborhood or high salaries to the managers of the charity.

We studied all the possible ways to eliminate costs and took two important decisions:

- 1. To use volunteers and part-time staff instead of full time staff
- 2. To adopt the concept of 'virtual office'

Our overheads are less than 10% of our donations based on the figures of 2007-08.

volunteers work together?

We have two types of volunteers. Office volunteers perform all office functions including budgeting, planning, marketing, accounting and technology support.

In addition of our team of office volunteers, we also have a team of field volunteers and coordinators in Pakistan who perform all the tasks requiring face-



to-face interaction with beneficiaries including visiting their home, place of work or educational institutions, payments and

performing reviews, marketing visits and conducting workshops.

Both the office and field volunteer teams are managed by our Management Committee. These teams communicate with each other through the mobile communication and our virtual office called 'Beneficiary Management System' (BMS).

What is a Virtual Office?

Beneficiary Management System (BMS) is our

virtual office. The concept of 'Virtual Office' means an online and paper-



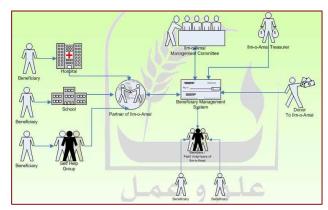
less environment that enables a network of volunteers to contribute efficiently by using online communication technologies. Our volunteers need a PC, an Internet access, scanner and a digital camera for the virtual office.

Ilm-o-Amal does not maintain a brick-andmortar office. With the new communication technologies in the form of Internet and



mobile phones we are able to reduce our overheads by working from our homes and offices.

We rely on BMS and communication technologies to collaborate and deliver our services smoothly on-time and with minimum costs.

Our programs

We provide the following types of help to deserving families:

- Family assistance for food, medicine, rent or any other basic necessity. Maximum amount Rs 3,000/- per month.
- Educational Scholarships.
 Maximum amount Rs 600/- per month.
- Income Opportunity for small enterprise. Maximum amount Rs. 15,000/- once.
- Any exceptions for more deserving cases are approved on a case-by-case basis

Ilm-o-Amal team verifies and approves the posted applications

Our team consisting of our management committee, coordinators and field volunteers verify the application. The people in need are initially supported by our funds.

Beneficiary Management System (BMS)

Beneficiary Management System (BMS) is a webbased application developed by the Ilm-o-Amal Association. The Members of the Association can access it anytime, and from anywhere through an Internet connection. BMS provides a secure and collaborative environment to the Members of the Association to:

- Launch Welfare Projects
- Manage Applications
- Manage Payment/Disbursements
- Collaborate with other Members
- Share information & discuss ideas
- Download documents and forms

It requires a valid 'Username' and 'Password'. It is hosted in a secured environment. It is developed with software tools under GNU Public License including PHP and mySQL database

Fund Raising and Donations: develop materials for events, managing donor information, managing donation leader programs

Finance & Accounting: payments, monthly accounting reports, budgeting

Application Reviews: working with field volunteer to identify the applications to be reviewed and updated BMS with the results of the review

Operations: help us create beneficiaries and application and perform follow ups

Developing Programs: developing new programs and their contents. We are currently working on several projects related to education and family support. You can participate in these projects.

What follows?

- Review: A volunteer coordinator will review your form and communicate with you identify the areas where you can add value.
- **Briefing:** A briefing session will be arranged with a coordinator to explain our processes.
- Access rights: An access for you will be created to the BMS and our file system.
- Task Assignment: Volunteer will be assigned to work with the coordinator of the specific area (marketing, finance etc)

Some words of advice

Volunteering is fun and rewarding, but it can also be a little more complicated than just showing up and having a good time. Here is some advice on how to make the most of your volunteer work:

- Be selfless. Selfless is the opposite of selfish. Don't think about what you can do to help yourself. Think about what you can do to help others.
- Be well-trained. Know what you're doing as a volunteer. If you need some time to learn your job, take that time. If you need training or need someone to show you what you're supposed to do, speak up. If you're good at your job, it will be much easier to help others (plus you'll have a lot more fun).
- Be dependable. Do what you say you'll do, and do your best. Don't show up late, and always keep your promises. People will be relying on you so you don't want to let them down.
- Be enthusiastic. Don't moan and groan your way through your volunteer work. If you really don't like what you're doing, find something else. Always have a positive attitude and show others that you're doing this because you WANT to.
- Be open-minded. One of the really great things about being a volunteer is the chance to learn and experience new things. Keep your mind open to new possibilities, and you'll probably grow as a person.

- Be respectful. Always remember to show respect for other people and other cultures. Keep in mind that your way of thinking or living is not the only way there is. Be cooperative. Don't be a (hot shot or a loner. Don't try to do everything yourself. Work as part of a team to make sure everyone gets a chance to participate and do his or her fair share of work. If someone asks for help, be willing to lend a hand. If you need some help, ask politely for it.
- **Be understanding.** Try to see things through other people's eyes. Try your best to understand what other people are going through, even it's something you've never dealt with yourself.
- Be humble. Humble people don't brag or go around telling everyone about all the good things they've done just to get some attention or feel superior. They're happy knowing that they're making a difference, and don't need to shout about it.
- Be friendly. Treat others like friends, and they'll do the same for you. Many people who volunteer meet new people with whom they want to stay friends. You might just meet someone who becomes a buddy for the rest of your life!
