



About Ilm-o-Amal Mobile Library

1. What is a Mobile Library?

It is a free service from Ilm-o-Amal Association in which a field librarian visits the school with books

3. Is it a free service?

Yes. However, the school can opt to voluntarily contribute a monthly fee to help us meet the operational expenses of the library. A recommended amount is Rs 1000 per month.

5. What types of Books are in the library?

The library will have a vast collection of English and Urdu books which are of interest to children from Nursery to Grade 10. It includes stories, fiction and scientific books and magazines. See library catalogue here

7. How many books the librarian will bring during each visit?

Between 50 to 100 books

9. Does the library have course material?

At this stage the library does not have course material but plan to have them in future. Once this facility is available it will be communicated to the schools.

2. How many times the field librarian will visit the school?

Generally the field volunteer visits the school once a week for 2 hours

4. What type of facilities the school must provide?

School must provide a room with table(s) and chairs for 2 hours for each visit by the librarian. School must also designate a responsible person to assist the librarian if required.

6. Who can borrow a book from the library?

Any student of the school who fills the library membership form and gets it attested from the principal will get a membership of the library and can borrow books.

8. How many books can a member borrow?

A member can borrow up to 3 books at one time.

10. What are the areas covered by this service?

At present this service is available to schools in North Karachi and adjacent towns

12. What are the next steps?

A member of Ilm-o-Amal will visit the school to meet the Principal and discuss the library and its processes in details.
